Culture Days runs over 4 weekends in September and October each year. 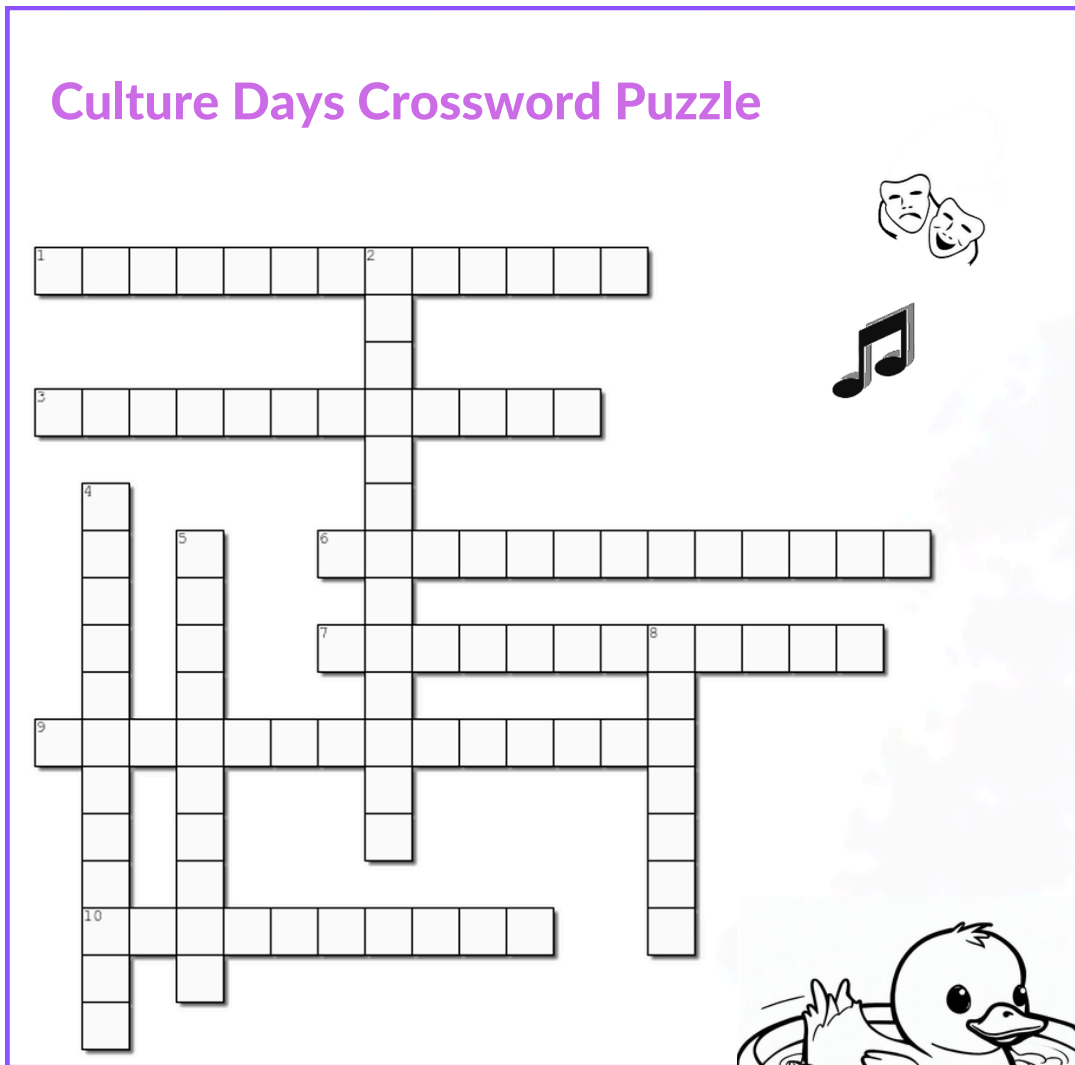


Map Of Halton Hills
